Aged for 32 months in 100% new French oak, the 2016 Cabernet Ticino First Reserve is a pure Cabernet Sauvignon from low-yielding vines in the Mendrisotto. Elegant and fresh on the remarkably pure and aromatic nose, this is a round and charming, silky-textured and elegant Cabernet with ripe, intense and persistent fruit and a chalky-finessed character with power and aromatic intensity. The tannins are fine, firm and fresh and lead to a long, tight and tensioned finish with persistent intensity. This is an excellent, strict but lush, refined and elegant Cabernet from the Ticino that should have excellent aging potential. Decant before serving. Tasted in February 2020.
