The 2015 Cinque is a blend of 50/50 Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon that both reached perfect ripeness levels that year. Picked at low yields (35-40 hectoliters per hectare) in the third week of September and the first week of October, this Mendrisotto Bordeaux blend offers a generously ripe, precise, refined and elegant bouquet of red fruits and milled stony notes. Silky textured and super elegant on the palate, this is a finessed and intense, very persistent red with fine tannins and delicate acidity. The finish is stimulatingly fine and salty as well as concentrated and long in its ripe and sweet fruit flavors. Doubtlessly an extraordinary Bordeaux blend from the Ticino. Tasted in February 2020.
